Shuaib reminded the commission that the budget for Student Activities is \$9,000.
- VI. Unfinished Business
 - A. Psi Chi Funding Request – Discussion/Action Item
The Commission will discuss the possibility of funding Psi Chi's Celebration of Achievement and Services Award
Villanueva asked if Psi Chi would be doing any fund raising for the event. Harms replied that they would not due to the size of the event. Isika asked Harms if Psi Chi thought about reducing the \$3,750 requested. They did think about it, but concluded that if they decrease the funding they are asking for it would increase the price of the tickets. Shuaib asked, after mentioning, according to ASI records, 88 people attended CASA last year, why do they estimate 250 guests this year. Harms explained that 88 guests

did attend the first year of the event, and that last year the turnout was doubled; they had to turn people away. Therefore, this year, they want to accommodate more guests.

The party favors are still being worked on; so far, they just have party hats. Isika wants the organization to go to provide more detailed information regarding this event and the funds they are requesting. Shuaib entertain motion to table this for next week on November 16.
